Farewell, President Tom!

President & CEO Tom Kleinhanzl announced his retirement effective October 31, 2025, after 20 years of dedicated service. From the start of his tenure, Tom was focused on a transformative goal: enhancing medical services to ensure patients in Frederick County could access exceptional care close to home. And he did just that—and so much more.

Under Tom's leadership, Frederick Health introduced groundbreaking programs and facilities, including the CyberKnife Center, Interventional Cardiology, Electrophysiology, the Stroke Center, Bariatric Surgery, and Robotic Surgery. Additional milestones included the creation of the Frederick Health Auxiliary Prenatal Center, the Frederick Health Dental Clinic, the James M Stockman Cancer Institute, the Frederick Health Breast Center, and the Center for Precision Medicine and Genetics. Additionally, Tom championed higher education partnerships, fostering the creation of programs such as the Hood College Nursing Program and Mount Saint Mary's Master of Health Administration Program, which continue to develop the next generation of healthcare professionals.

Throughout his career, Tom received numerous accolades, such as the Boy Scouts of America Distinguished Frederick Citizen of the Year, the American Hospital Association Grassroots Champion Award, Maryland Daily Record's Most Admired CEO, Frederick County Office of Economic Development's Top 50 CEO, and inclusion in Becker's Hospital Review's "160 Community Hospital CEOs to Know."

Tom also played an active role in the fundraising campaigns that helped make so much of our progress possible, always leading by example and inspiring others to support our shared mission. During his tenure (Fiscal Year 2004–present), Frederick Health raised nearly \$105 million in charitable support! Tom's legacy is one of vision, compassion, and servant leadership—and we are forever grateful for the difference he has made.

Together, we will continue building a future where every individual and family receives the support they need during some of life's most important moments."

Hospice Dollars at Work

The mission of Frederick Health Hospice is to positively impact the well-being of every individual in our community affected by serious illness, grief and loss. Gifts to Frederick Health Hospice help support medical, emotional, spiritual and bereavement services for individuals with a life-limiting illness and their families. Charitable support ensures that Frederick Health Hospice can continue to provide non-reimbursable services at no charge and honor its commitment to never turn anyone away, regardless of ability to pay. Below are some examples of Hospice charitable dollars at work.



Kline Hospice House

The Kline Hospice House provides residential hospice care for patients in their last weeks of life. Located on 14 acres of peaceful farm land in rural Frederick County, the Kline Hospice House is designed with comfort, family, and relaxation in mind. With a 24-hour onsite caregiver and continued support and oversight from the Hospice care team of nurses, social workers, home health aides, spiritual coordinators and volunteers—families can trust that their loved one is comfortable and safe.



Music Therapy

Frederick Health Hospice offers Music Therapy services to patients and families to enhance physical and emotional comfort through specialized, clinical interventions. The Music Therapist will develop individualized therapy plans and visit schedules based on the patient's needs and goals such as pain relief, reduced anxiety and agitation, ease of respiratory symptoms, support for depression, enhanced communication, and the opportunity for meaningful family involvement. The visits are included in Hospice services at no additional cost to the patient/family.



Camp Jamie

Camp Jamie is a special opportunity for grieving children, adolescents and teens to come together to talk about their feelings related to the death of someone special, and learn coping skills for dealing with those feelings. In addition to grief education and support, campers also enjoy camp activities such as team games, arts/crafts, hiking, campfires with storytellers, and pet therapy. Thanks to charitable support, Camp Jamie is provided at no charge.



Veteran's Program

Frederick Health Hospice is a 4-star national partner of We Honor Veterans. Frederick Health Hospice's knowledgeable Veteran Liaisons are committed to assisting veterans with accessing VA and state veteran benefits, including obtaining discharge documents, medals and awards, enrolling in the VA healthcare system, applying for VA survivor benefits, burial in veteran cemeteries, and more. In addition, Veteran Liaisons also perform recognition ceremonies to honor the veteran's service.

Fundraising Update:

Care for a Lifetime Campaign

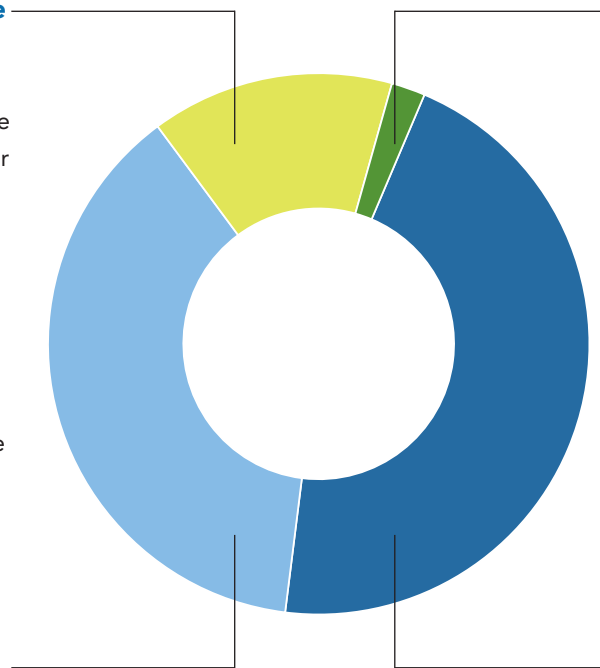
Care for a Lifetime is our first fundraising campaign built around funding pillars, each focused on a critical area of need within our healthcare system. This new structure not only supports essential funding priorities, but also allows donors to make a personal impact by directing their gifts to a program or service that resonates most with them. In Fiscal Year 2025 (June 2024–July 2025), we raised a total of **\$4,465,885** toward our fundraising goal of \$25,000,000. Below is a breakdown of the campaign dollars received.

Pillar One: Clinical Service Lines & Patient Care \$648,247.34

Pillar One is designed to advance the most essential and high-demand clinical services across our healthcare system. Examples of gifts we have received under Pillar One include those supporting the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Labor & Delivery, the Stroke Center, the Thoracic Oncology Program, and Behavioral Health.

Pillar Two: Community Health \$1,691,323.65

Support of Pillar Two will help expand our preventative health initiatives, improve our outreach and education efforts, and help strengthen our clinical programs that provide access to care for our community's most vulnerable. Examples of gifts we have received under Pillar Two include those supporting Frederick Health Hospice and Safety Net Services.



Pillar Three: Empowering Health Professionals \$90,275.14

Gifts to Pillar Three will help fuel initiatives that attract top talent across disciplines, while also creating growth opportunities for existing staff through continuing education, training, and mentorship. We have received numerous gifts under Pillar Three designated to support nursing scholarships.

Unrestricted Gifts \$2,036,039.09

This portion of funds donated represents gifts to the Care for a Lifetime Campaign that were not designated to support a specific Funding Pillar. This includes unrestricted Campaign gifts and pledges from our giving club members, as well as gifts to support the Area of Greatest Need and those that supported the 2024 Annual Appeal.

Care for a Lifetime

Campaign Donor Spotlights

Rose Marie Myers recently supported the Care for a Lifetime Campaign with a generous donation of \$25,000 to benefit the Infusion Center at the James M Stockman Cancer Institute. Rose Marie, 95, has been a member of the Frederick Health Auxiliary since 1984. She currently volunteers at the Infusion Center two days a week and often picks up extra shifts to fill in for others. As a volunteer, Rose Marie cleans and restocks stations between patients in addition to socializing with patients when appropriate and helping them feel comfortable and less stressed during their treatment. When asked what inspired her to support the Infusion Center with such a generous gift, Rose Marie replied that she “is so in love with every one of them—the patients and nurses alike” and she simply wanted to support their hard work and help with any upgrades needed at the Center.

Rose Marie is known among patients, staff, and her fellow Auxiliary members as a bright, positive light. Her Auxiliary vest is adorned with numerous recognition pins, but in true Rose Marie fashion, she avoids talking about her achievements, saying that “the pins are not that important, but what is important is that I am still able to do something I love—that makes me happy.”

The Hurwitz Breast Cancer Fund recently supported the Care for a Lifetime Campaign with a donation of \$307,644.20 to further advance early detection and treatment of breast cancer. This generous gift provides equipment and staffing support necessary for the growth of the hospital’s clinical trials program, funds an early cancer detection test for individuals who are high-risk and gene mutation positive, establishes the foundation for an initiative that will provide specimen-based Precision Medicine Research, and enables the expansion of the Nurse Navigator program which provides individualized support to newly diagnosed patients and decreases wait times from diagnosis to treatment.

When **Jarad and Acacia Bowens** moved to Frederick in 2020, they arrived just as the COVID-19 pandemic began to unfold. Originally from Florida, they didn't know anyone in their new town of Frederick—but you'd never know that now. Today, the couple is not only well-connected, but deeply engaged in the community they've come to call home.

Both Jarad and Acacia bring a spirit of service into everything they do. "We believe in community—it's a core value that brought us together," Acacia shares. This belief continues to guide how they live, work, and give. For them, community isn't just about belonging—it's about showing up, asking what's needed, and finding meaningful ways to help.

As the former owner of Benefactor Events, a full-service mobile DJ and entertainment company, Jarad provided entertainment services to local nonprofit organizations at little to no cost. Jarad sold the company after the pandemic and currently works for the City of Frederick's Office of Equity & Inclusion where he administers programs that support minority and women-owned businesses. Acacia is the founder of Ak's GraFix & Photo, a marketing and branding agency offering graphic and web design, content marketing, and photography services. With a background in the nonprofit world, Acacia has a first-hand understanding of the importance of giving back. She, too, offers discounted rates to nonprofits. "We're only as strong as our community," Acacia says. "This is true as a business owner too. How can you ask the community to help you if you're not willing to help them?"

Jarad and Acacia also devote their time and talents to a variety of local organizations. Jarad serves on the Board of Directors for the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce. He is also a founding member of SOUL Street, a nonprofit dedicated to empowering the Black business community. Acacia is also actively engaged with the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce and serves on the Board of Directors of the Boys & Girls Club of Frederick County.

Jarad and Acacia joined the Order of the Good Samaritan in 2024—a decision that was also rooted in personal experience. Their daughter was born at Frederick Health. Their son has been in the Emergency Department on more than one occasion. Most recently, Jarad's mother was in the hospital for a length of time. "Knowing that my family is going to be taken care of here—that's important to me. And not just for our family, but that the access is there for everyone in our community," Jarad shares. "Health is the equalizer," adds Acacia. "It impacts us all. It doesn't matter what you have in life—health is the number one priority. This is why supporting Frederick Health is so important."

Jarad and Acacia find it rewarding to know that their support is making a positive difference in the lives of others. "It's often easier to see and feel the impact of a large charitable gift in a small nonprofit, but for a larger nonprofit like Frederick Health, it's about the collective impact of those who support it," Jarad says. "Every little bit, every person, every donor who pitches in helps push the mission forward. Many hands make light work."

WHY WE GIVE



For **Alison Bomba and Tate Safford**, joining the Order of the Good Samaritan was more than a gesture of support—it was a way to champion a cause that is deeply meaningful to them: Frederick Health Hospice.

Alison is a licensed psychologist and owns a solo, private practice in Frederick where she treats children, adolescents, and young adults. Specializing in grief therapy, Alison was drawn to volunteer with Frederick Health Hospice's Camp Jamie—a free, weekend-long bereavement camp for children coping with the loss of a loved one. After her first camp experience, Alison was struck by the tragedies that the young campers had endured—and equally moved by the strength and resilience that emerged as they connected with one another. For the past four years, Alison has served as the camp psychologist, floating between groups to support campers, big buddies, and counselors alike. She also leads the camp's "sharing circles," a space for emotional processing and healing. "Camp Jamie is magical. There's nothing like a group of peers with similar experiences coming together and sharing their stories," Alison shares. "It's the most healing thing I've ever witnessed. They heal themselves. I feel so fortunate to be a small part of what happens there."

As Alison and Tate learned more about the broader work of Frederick Health Hospice and its far-reaching impact on our community, they felt called to do more. They joined the Order of the Good Samaritan in 2024, and through the Care for a Lifetime Campaign, they were able to designate their pledge to support Hospice. Later that year, Alison joined the Frederick Health Hospice Board of Directors.

"I see my role as an ambassador," she says. "The more I've learned about Hospice and end-of-life care, the more passionate I've become about spreading the word and debunking myths." Alison shared that while commonly associated with end-of-life care, Hospice's impact reaches much further, through grief support, school-based counseling, educational outreach, and compassionate guidance for patients and families at all stages of loss. "Frederick Health Hospice is unique because it provides essential services that touch every corner of our community," she says.

Alison and Tate's commitment to Hospice is also shaped by personal loss. They have sadly experienced the loss of several loved ones—many of whom were young. These experiences underscored just how essential Hospice services are—and how important it is for people to understand what Hospice truly is and what options for care are available. Tate reflected on his mother's passing: "My mother passed in a hospital room. The best we could do was put music on. It was cold. I wish she could have been in a place like the Kline Hospice House—somewhere peaceful."

For Alison and Tate, investing in Hospice means investing in a future where more people are informed and prepared for life's most difficult moments. "We will all experience death. It would be wonderful if everyone better understood the value of Hospice services so truly informed end-of-life decisions could be made," Alison says. Through their generosity and advocacy, Alison and Tate are helping to ensure that others can navigate grief and loss with clarity, guidance, and support.

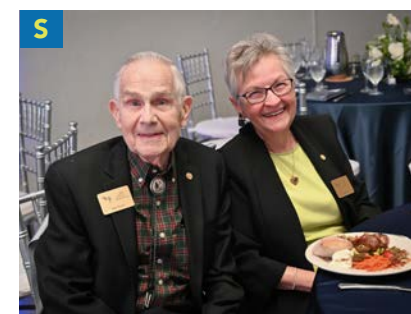

Good Samaritans *of the Year*

First presented in 1991, the Good Samaritan of the Year Award is the highest recognition conveyed upon an individual by Frederick Health and recognizes deserving individuals for their selfless commitment to improving the quality of life in Frederick County. Our 2025 honorees were **Mark & Judy Lancaster**, who were recognized for their outstanding leadership, volunteerism and community service.

Mark Lancaster founded Lancaster Craftsmen Builders in 1979, an award-winning custom home design and construction company serving Central Maryland. His wife, Judy, serves as the company's chief financial officer, overseeing essential operations in addition to coordinating settlements and assisting with product development and interior designs. In addition to running a successful business, Mark actively served on the boards of Habitat for Humanity, Beyond Shelter, Interfaith Housing, and Rebuilding Together Frederick—using his experience to support efforts that provide safe, affordable housing to our most vulnerable neighbors—those with limited financial means, elderly individuals, people living with disabilities, and others facing housing insecurity.

Mark and Judy lend their professional expertise to greater good, and the same skills and knowledge that have made them respected leaders in the building industry are generously shared to serve those most in need. Together, they're currently leading the efforts to transform the Spring Bank Farm in North Frederick into a collaborative, nonprofit center dedicated to serving seniors in our community. The Center will break ground this fall for necessary renovations with a targeted opening in the fall of 2026.



Mark and Judy have both been long-time supporters of the Boys & Girls Club of Frederick County, an organization committed to serving youth in disadvantaged circumstances. Mark served as Chair, and under his leadership, its signature event—Tour de Frederick—blossomed into one of the most successful fundraisers in the area. Judy was just as integral—serving as full-time treasurer and volunteer for Tour de Frederick for many years. Mark also drove a partnership between the Boys & Girls Club and Frederick County Public Schools that led to the creation of the Club’s Madison Street location. Mark and Judy led the charge together—fundraising, designing, and overseeing construction.

Mark and Judy were instrumental in the founding of SOAR, a local nonprofit dedicated to supporting older adults through resources. Judy serves as President of the Board, bringing her energy, passion, and attention to detail that has fueled countless successful initiatives and growth of the organization. She also served on the Board of Directors for the Greater Maryland Chapter of the Alzheimer’s Association, where she chaired its Memory Ball Dancing Stars fundraiser for six years. Mark is an active member and past president of the Rotary Club of Frederick. During his presidency, which fell during the start of the COVID pandemic, he initiated and coordinated a grocery delivery program for local seniors. Most recently, Mark was his Club’s leader working with the Rotary Club of Carroll Creek to construct their joint Sailing Through the Winter Solstice boat, “The Yellow Rotary Submarine,” with proceeds benefitting the proposed Splash Pad in Baker Park.

Mark and Judy are also dedicated supporters of the arts. Mark serves on the Board of Directors for the Frederick Arts Council, chairing the building committee and working with the arts community to secure performance spaces and public art throughout the region. Both Mark and Judy are active members of the Weinberg Center for the Arts Tivoli Society. Judy served on the Board of Directors for the Weinberg, where she helped lead several transformative upgrades to the historic venue that benefit both performers and patrons alike, including the new marquee on West Patrick Street, the bar renovations, and the updates to the green room.

In addition to their community involvement and volunteer efforts, Mark and Judy are also generous philanthropists and support many local nonprofit organizations, including Frederick Health.

Joann and William Phillips have been members of the 1902 Club since 2023. Joann, originally from Ohio, moved to Maryland in 1984 and met William in 1987. The couple settled in Middletown in 1995 and married in 2000. Now retired, Joann keeps a full schedule—she has served on the Frederick Health Development Council's Annual Support Committee since 2023 as a fundraising volunteer. She is on the Board for the Middletown Area Chamber of Commerce, she is actively involved with WISH (Women Inspiring Supporting & Helping), and she is the Education Coordinator for the Frederick Millionaire Makers chapter of BNI (Business Network International) Central Maryland. Joann is also a consultant with Arbonne International, a health and wellness company offering vegan skincare, cosmetic, and nutritional products. She recently celebrated 20 years with the company and currently serves as a district manager.

William was born in Washington, D.C. and moved to Maryland in 1976. He served in the United States Army and is a veteran of the Vietnam War. He spent over three decades working for the Architect of the Capitol. Now retired, William teaches clay sculpture classes from his home studio and finds deep satisfaction in creating art—and inspiring others to do so as well. He has three sons and six grandchildren—several of whom work in the healthcare field.

The couple's support of Frederick Health began when Joann was invited to learn more about the hospital's fundraising efforts. What she discovered surprised her. "I didn't know Frederick Health was a 501(c)(3)," Joann recalls. She found it eye-opening to learn how state policy impacts the hospital's financial operations and just how

essential philanthropy is to bridging this gap. This insight inspired her to join the Annual Support Committee as a fundraising volunteer. "As a fundraising volunteer, I've learned that we not only need support from the community—we also have a responsibility to help educate the community on why that support matters," she explains.

Joann and William's connection to Frederick Health is also personal. William has visited the Emergency Department several times, where he received great care and was particularly moved by the compassionate, supportive nature of the staff. "I believe that people have auras," he says. "The hospital staff have good auras. They all have their own lives outside of work, they may have problems they're dealing with, but you'd never know it. When you're sick or in pain, they make you laugh. They try to comfort you." Joann, too, has experienced the hospital's care firsthand. "The staff are so pleasant and so helpful in the worst of circumstances," she shares. "I've always had a good experience in the few times I've been there."

Joann and William believe strongly in the hospital's mission. "We believe the hospital is committed to keeping up with the most advanced technology and recruiting top-level staff and medical professionals," says Joann. "Every dollar invested in the hospital better enables the staff to serve the community. Potential donors need to know that every dollar given stays right here in the hospital, benefitting our friends and neighbors." When asked what they're most hopeful for when thinking about the impact of their giving, Joann replied: "Our hope is that the hospital remains strong and continues to innovate and grow."

The majority of Angel Fund contributions are made by Frederick Health employees via payroll deduction. The Angel Fund is governed and administered by the Angel Fund Committee, a group of Frederick Health employees serving on a voluntary basis. Since the Fund's inception, more than \$456,600 has been granted to employees and 360 employees have benefitted from an Angel Fund grant.
