A Message from Our President

Dear Friends,

More than 124 years ago, a door opened in Frederick—marking the beginning of a legacy of care that continues today. That legacy began with the vision and generosity of Emma Smith, our founder and very first donor, who purchased seven acres of land on the outskirts of town for \$350 and helped set in motion the work to establish a hospital for the citizens of Frederick. In 1902, Frederick City Hospital—now Frederick Health—welcomed its first patients, thanks to Emma’s leadership and the early fundraising efforts of neighbors across the community. Together, they laid the foundation for the culture of philanthropy we know today—one rooted in compassion, shared responsibility, and the belief that exceptional care should be available close to home.

Last fall, one of the original doors to Frederick City Hospital was beautifully restored and unveiled inside the main entrance of Frederick Health Hospital. It is a special reminder of where we began—and of the many doors that philanthropy has helped open since: doors to new and expanded services, doors to emergency care and cancer treatment, and doors to comfort, hope, healing, and innovation. Over the years, Frederick Health has evolved in remarkable ways to meet the changing needs of those we serve. Yet through every chapter of our history, philanthropy has remained a constant force—fueling our progress and making it possible to care for our community in new and meaningful ways.

In July 2024, we launched the Care for a Lifetime Campaign, a five-year, \$25 million fundraising initiative that gives donors the opportunity to support the areas of care most important to them while helping address critical needs across our healthcare system. I’m pleased to share that in the first two years of the campaign, we’ve raised \$9,394,923 toward our fundraising goal. I invite you to learn more about the campaign in the pages ahead.

As I enter my second year as President & CEO—and reflect on 29 years as a member of this extraordinary team—I feel deeply grateful for the legacy that brought us here and the future we are building together. Campaign Update: **Care for a Lifetime**

Thanks to the generosity of many members of our donor family, the Care for a Lifetime Campaign continues to make progress as we enter year three of this five-year, \$25 million fundraising initiative. The Care for a Lifetime Campaign is designed to advance Frederick Health's mission in meaningful and measurable ways, while supporting the strategic goals established by our leadership team and Board of Directors—individuals who understand firsthand the needs of our community and the people we serve.

Care for a Lifetime is the first fundraising campaign in our history to be built around funding pillars, each focused on a critical area of need within our healthcare system. This new structure helps ensure charitable support is aligned with our most essential funding priorities while giving donors a more personal way to make an impact—by supporting the programs and services that resonate most with them. Through a thoughtful review of health trends, patient volumes, service gaps, and the evolving needs of our workforce, we identified the areas where philanthropy can have the greatest and most lasting impact. From that process, the following three funding pillars were created:

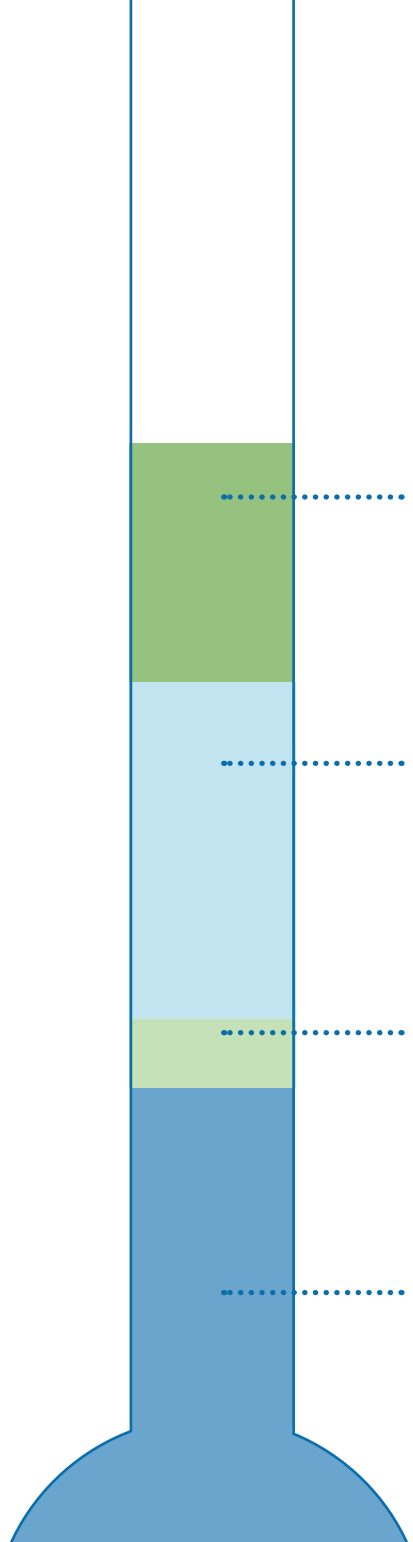

Fundraising Progress

To date (between July 1, 2024-June 30, 2026), we have raised a total of **\$9,394,923** toward our fundraising goal of \$25,000,000. Below is a breakdown of the campaign dollars received:



Pillar One

Clinical Service Lines & Patient Care | \$2,022,356.78

Pillar One is focused on advancing our essential, high-demand clinical services through investments in patient care, technology, early detection and treatment, and modernized facilities across our healthcare system. Examples of gifts we have received under Pillar One include those supporting the Precision Medicine & Genetics Program, the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Labor & Delivery, the James M Stockman Cancer Institute, the Stroke Center, the Thoracic Oncology Program, and Behavioral Health.

Pillar Two

Community Health | \$3,035,891.67

Pillar Two supports our efforts to deliver more accessible, personalized care through preventative health initiatives, outreach and education, and clinical programs that help connect our most vulnerable community members with the care they need and deserve. Examples of gifts we have received under Pillar Two include those supporting Frederick Health Hospice, Family Connects, the Cancer Patient Assistance Fund, the Comprehensive Care Center, and Safety Net Services.

Pillar Three

Empowering Health Professionals | \$253,609.73

Pillar Three is designed to help strengthen and sustain our workforce by investing in the people behind our mission—supporting initiatives that attract top talent across disciplines, expand opportunities for continued growth through education, training, and mentorship, and foster a culture of recognition, gratitude, and support. We have received numerous gifts under Pillar Three designated to support nursing scholarships.

Unrestricted Gifts | \$4,083,065.15

This portion of funds donated reflects gifts that help advance the broader goals of the Care for a Lifetime Campaign. This includes unrestricted Campaign gifts and pledges from our giving club members that were not designated to a specific Funding Pillar, as well as contributions to support the Area of Greatest Need.

When Gratitude Inspires **Generosity**

Dusty and Kris Rood have built their lives around the values of family, service, and community—and the belief that when you're fortunate enough to be able to give back, you should. Their most recent gift to the **Frederick Health Birth Place** reflects those values in a deeply personal way, honoring a space that has been part of their own family's story while helping ensure future families can experience the same care, comfort, and support as they begin new chapters of their own.



When Dusty and Kris Rood think about what makes Frederick special, they both return to the same idea: connection. For Kris, that connection is found in the everyday gathering places that bring people together—the library, downtown, school communities, youth sports, and the many activities that give Frederick its sense of warmth and belonging. Kris came to Frederick from Connecticut, first settling downtown and later in Urbana, where she and Dusty now live with their three children, ages 13, 10, and 7. She earned her master’s degree in educational leadership and spent 10 years teaching language arts, largely in Loudoun County, Virginia. Today, Kris dedicates her time and energy to the people and places that support Frederick families through her volunteer work with local schools, youth sports, and moms’ groups.

For Dusty, whose family history in Frederick stretches back eight generations, Frederick’s beauty lies in “the diversity and uniqueness of its places and its landscapes.” He sees Frederick as a “big, small city”—large enough to grow, evolve, and offer opportunity, while remaining close-knit enough for relationships to matter and individual actions to make a visible difference. As President & CEO of Rodgers Consulting, a Maryland-based land development, civil engineering and urban planning firm, Dusty carries that same sense of connection and purpose into his work.

Family life keeps Dusty and Kris busy, but giving back remains a shared priority. As parents, they are especially drawn to causes that support children and families, including early childcare and education—areas that reflect their belief that every child deserves the strongest possible start in life. For them, philanthropy is a practical expression of that belief—a way to carry their commitment to children and families into action. Since joining the Order of the Good Samaritan in 2013, Dusty and Kris have consistently supported Frederick Health with quiet humility, motivated not by recognition, but by a sincere belief in making the community a better place. Through Rodgers Consulting, Dusty has also helped sustain a corporate commitment to Frederick Health, as the firm has been a member of the Corporate Honor Roll since 1999.

In 2025, Dusty and Kris learned about the Frederick Health Birth Place renovation project, a key priority of the Care for a Lifetime Campaign. The project immediately resonated with them—not only because of what it will mean for future patients and families, but because the Birth Place is part of their own family’s story. It is where all three of their children were born, and supporting the project became a natural way to express their gratitude for the care they received while helping ensure other families feel welcomed, reassured, and supported during one of life’s most meaningful milestones.

“We were very lucky,” Kris says. “I had fairly easy pregnancies, and Labor and Delivery were wonderful experiences—in large part because of the nurses. I still remember the nurse from 13 years ago. She was so supportive and so caring.” Those memories have stayed with Kris—not only because of what happened clinically, but because of how she felt in those moments: cared for, confident, and surrounded by compassion. “I want other people within our community to also have a similar type of experience,” Kris says. Kris also thinks about mothers, babies, and families whose experiences may be more difficult, more uncertain, or shaped by greater barriers to care. For them, she believes, the ability to receive trusted care close to home matters deeply. “I want other families to feel like they can stay and be taken care of right within their own community,” she says.

And as Kris and Dusty think about the future their own children may one day choose for themselves, the project feels even more personal. “If our kids decided to live in Frederick and have families of their own, we hope they’d choose Frederick Health,” Kris says. “How can we make sure Frederick Health is still thriving and competitive?” It is a question that carries their family’s gratitude into a broader commitment to the hospital’s future.

For Dusty, the personal meaning behind their gift also connects naturally to the way he thinks about leadership and community investment. As a business leader, he believes that investing in the places and institutions residents depend on is not simply good business—it is a responsibility. “Philanthropy is the enabler,” he says. “It’s the difference between something being good and something being great.” Healthcare, he adds, is a vital part of Frederick’s community ecosystem—the network of businesses, nonprofits, civic partners, and public institutions that help the county thrive. As Frederick continues to grow, Dusty believes change must be met with intention and collaboration, so the places and services residents rely on can remain strong.

Dusty and Kris’ support of the Birth Place brings their story full circle: from the care that supported their own family’s beginnings to the care future Frederick families will count on for years to come. For them, the gift is an investment in continuity—in new beginnings, in trusted local care, and in the kind of community where families can feel supported through every stage of life. It is also a reflection of the example they hope to set for their own children: that communities are shaped by the people who choose to step forward and give back. Their generosity will help ensure that as Frederick continues to grow, the care that has meant so much to their own family will be there for others, too.

Generational Giving: **The Anderabi Family Legacy**

The Anderabi family's McDonald's enterprise has grown steadily over the years, reaching nine locations across Frederick, Washington, and Montgomery Counties. Through that growth, the family has continued to see service as something larger than the meals they serve each day—it is found in the opportunities they create, the people they support, and the generosity they extend to the community around them.



When Syed Anderabi came to the United States from Pakistan in 1972, he arrived as a student eager to learn, work hard, and build a future. He studied at the University of Texas, where he earned his master's degree in economics and later completed another master's degree in business administration. While pursuing his education, he worked at the campus McDonald's, quickly rising through the ranks and learning the business from the inside out. Then one day, his boss asked him: "Do you want to work *for* McDonald's, or do you want to *own* one?" Syed decided to take a chance—and what began as a job became the foundation for a family business.

Syed's wife, Sadia, a fellow native of Pakistan, came to the United States in 1989 as an Ambassador of Goodwill. The opportunity allowed her, as Syed recalls, "to do some teaching and learning at the same time." Sadia was trained as a clinical psychologist—thoughtful, compassionate, and deeply attuned to the needs of others. She and Syed married in 1990, and before long, they became not only partners in life, but partners in business. Together, they opened their first McDonald's franchise in 1992. Although Syed's early experience helped open the door, he gives Sadia much of the credit for the success that followed. As the business grew, he stepped back and Sadia took the reins. "You can't have two people calling the shots," he says. Over the years, they expanded to nine successful franchise locations across Frederick, Washington, and Montgomery Counties.

Together, Syed and Sadia built the business with passion, purpose, and a shared understanding that success carried responsibility—to their employees, customers, and community. That sense of responsibility also guided their support of Frederick Health, where they saw a mission worth investing in. "The hospital does so many good things," Syed says. "We're proud to have this hospital here." For Syed, giving back is also a way to share the success made possible by the community they serve. "Our customers make us successful, and we need to share what we have with others," he says. The family's support of Frederick Health has spanned decades: Anderabi Enterprises has been a member of the Corporate Honor Roll since 1995, and Syed and Sadia extended their generosity personally by joining the Order of the Good Samaritan in 2009.

Frederick Health's mission became especially personal for the Anderabi family during Sadia's battle with cancer. As her condition progressed quickly, she was cared for first at the James M Stockman Cancer Institute and later at the Kline Hospice House before her passing in August 2024. For Syed and his family, the kindness and compassion they were shown during that difficult time stayed with them—and they were particularly touched when Hospice team members continued to check in and offer support after Sadia's passing.

Today, Sadia's influence continues through the values she and Syed instilled together—integrity, service, and a commitment to community—which remain central

to the family's next generation. Syed and Sadia's son, Murtaza, grew up immersed in the family business, gaining an early understanding of the hard work and care behind each location. The family's restaurants serve hundreds of guests each day—often between 800 and 1,000 at a single location—and employ hundreds of people.

Murtaza's wife, Asma, is now helping build on the Anderabi legacy. Like Sadia before her, she has become a visible leader in the family business. Born and educated in Pakistan, Asma came to the United States 10 years ago and, as she says with a smile, "married into McDonald's." She is now working to become a franchise owner—a process she emphasizes is based on qualifications, not family ties. "I had to make my place here," she says. "No exceptions are made." Asma credits Sadia and Syed as teachers and often turns to Murtaza for his lifelong knowledge of the business. Together, the family has more than 100 years of experience with McDonald's.

For Asma and Murtaza, carrying forward the family's business legacy also means continuing the philanthropic legacy Syed and Sadia began. In 2025, Asma and Murtaza joined the Order of the Good Samaritan to honor the family's tradition of generosity—and to express their own gratitude for Frederick Health, where both of their daughters were born. Asma says the care she received left a lasting impression, especially during the delivery of their second child, which took place during COVID. At a time when many families felt isolated, she remembers feeling supported every step of the way by the Labor & Delivery team. "The level of care that was provided was phenomenal," she recalls, remembering one nurse in particular whose presence brought comfort when she needed it most. "It was like having a sister," Asma says. Through their support, Asma and Murtaza hope to help ensure other growing families will be met with the same warmth, compassion, and care their family received.

For Syed, success has never been measured by the number of restaurants they own, but by the values behind their work. "I'm most proud of the way we do business," he says. "We try to do things the right way. It doesn't matter who is looking, we do the right thing." He sees those values continuing in Asma and Murtaza. In Asma, he sees echoes of Sadia's strong, capable, compassionate leadership. In Murtaza, he sees a steward of a family enterprise built on more than business alone. And when asked what he hopes for his grandchildren, Syed says: "I hope they grow up as good people." It is a hope that reflects the heart of the Anderabi family's story. Across generations, their legacy is not only one of entrepreneurship and success, but of humility, gratitude, service, and care for others.

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Why I Give

For **Gayon M. Sampson**, giving to Frederick Health is personal and purposeful, guided by a belief in accessible, equitable care for all.



A proud eighth-generation Frederick County native, Gayon Sampson's ties to this community reach back more than 200 years. "Frederick is more than my hometown—it's part of my identity and has shaped my values, my commitment to service, and my desire to give back to the community that has given so much to my family," he says. For Gayon, public service is both a career and a calling. He currently serves as Chief of Staff to the Comptroller of Maryland, following previous service as Chief of Staff to the Mayor of the City of Frederick. Gayon also serves on the boards of United Way of Frederick County, Baltimore Public Media, and the African American Resources Cultural and Heritage Society, and he is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Sons of the American Legion Francis Scott Key Post 11, the Ausherman Family Foundation Idea Grant Committee, and several other civic organizations. Each role speaks to his commitment to building a stronger, healthier, and more inclusive community.

In 2025, Gayon joined Frederick Health's donor family as a member of the Order of the Good Samaritan, inspired by his belief that strong communities depend on strong institutions—and that supporting them is a shared responsibility. His support is also personal, reflecting both his family's connection to the hospital and his awareness of the broader history of care and access in Frederick. "Generations of my family have been born at the hospital," he shares. "However, that was not always the experience for families who looked like mine. Before the creation of the Baker Wing, Black Americans in Frederick did not have the same access to healthcare and hospital services as many other residents. That history is an important reminder that access to quality healthcare has not always been guaranteed for everyone. Because of that history, I have a deep appreciation for the progress made and for the role Frederick Health plays today as an institution serving our entire community."

For Gayon, recognizing this progress also means acknowledging what remains to be done. "We know that Black Americans continue to experience poorer health outcomes and that Black women, in particular, face significantly higher rates of maternal health complications and mortality," he says. "Those disparities remind us that the work of improving health and expanding access is far from finished." Gayon believes that supporting Frederick Health is one way to help move that work forward. "Frederick Health's mission is important because it is about more than treating illness—it is about creating a healthier, more equitable community where everyone has the opportunity to thrive," he says.

Gayon's giving is both an act of gratitude and an investment in what comes next. "I often think about the legacy we inherit and the legacy we leave behind," he shares. "Supporting Frederick Health is one small way that I can help ensure that future generations inherit a community that is healthy, compassionate, and prepared to meet whatever challenges lie ahead." He hopes others will consider that legacy, too. "I would encourage others to think about all the ways Frederick Health has touched their lives or the lives of someone they know," Gayon says. "At some point, nearly all of us will rely on the care and compassion that this institution provides."

He also served on the FCNB Bank Board and was an active member of the Rotary Club and local Ruritan Club. In 2003, Gail received the Good Samaritan of the Year Award in recognition of his selfless contributions to the Frederick community.

Why We Give

For **Gary & Denise Rollins**, Frederick is more than a hometown—it is the place that shaped their values and inspired a shared life of service.



Gary and Denise Rollins have known Frederick all their lives: both were born at Frederick Memorial Hospital (now Frederick Health). After graduating from Frederick High School, Gary joined the Navy, and when he returned home from serving his country, he worked at Fort Detrick while searching for a meaningful way to continue serving others. He found that calling in mortuary science, eventually opening the Gary L. Rollins Funeral Home in 1993. Denise graduated from Linganore High School and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in accounting from the University of Maryland, College Park, followed by a master's in thanatology from Hood College and a PhD in marriage and family therapy from Eastern University. Denise's family history is uniquely tied to Frederick Health: her great-great-grandparents, Levin and Barbara Leakins, were initially buried at Greenmount Cemetery before the land was sold to Frederick City Hospital, and her great-grandfather, Albert Dixon, Frederick County's first Black mortician, conducted many burials there.

In 2009, Gary and Denise each experienced profound loss with the illnesses and deaths of their spouses. Their shared understanding of grief and healing deepened the compassion they brought to one another and, in time, to the families they would serve through their work. They married in 2012, and have been working and serving side by side ever since—with Gary as CEO and Denise as CFO of the funeral home. That same year, they moved into a newly built facility and adopted a new name—Rollins Life Celebration Center—to reflect their mission of helping families honor life amid loss.

Gary and Denise's dedication to helping others takes shape in many meaningful ways. Gary serves on the Board of the African American Resources Cultural and Heritage Society, and is a member of Mountain City Lodge #382. Denise serves on the Board of the Whole Heart Grief and Life Resource Center, a nonprofit she founded in 2013. She is also a member of the Ausherman Family Foundation Board of Trustees. Following her service on the Frederick Health Board of Directors from 2022 to June 2025, she became Frederick Health's Director of Consumer Experience, a role that allows her to advocate for patients and families while connecting with the community she loves.

Gary and Denise were drawn to support Frederick Health Hospice as Good Samaritans because its mission resonates deeply with them. Through their work with grieving families, they understand Hospice's role in helping loved ones face loss with dignity and support. “Every citizen will deal with loss at some point, which creates an incredible need for Hospice's meaningful work,” Denise says. Hospice has also touched their own family: Denise's grandmother received Hospice care for years, and Gary's mother received Hospice services in the hospital before she passed away last year. Grateful for the kindness and support Hospice provided, Gary and Denise hope their giving helps others experience the same level of care.

Their generosity reflects values instilled early in their lives. “We were both raised in households where we were taught that serving is both a responsibility and a privilege,” says Denise. “It is a blessing to share what we have with others.” Their support is also an expression of their love for Frederick, a “big” town that has retained its small-town feel, where they are proud to have raised their children and grandchildren—and where family extends to the many people they feel honored to know and love.

The Rhythm of Kindness

First presented in 1991, the **Good Samaritan of the Year Award** is the highest recognition conveyed upon an individual by Frederick Health and recognizes deserving individuals for their selfless commitment to improving the quality of life in Frederick County. Our 2026 honoree was **Bettie Jane Bryant**, who was posthumously recognized for her decades of community service, philanthropic leadership, and support for local cancer patients.

Bettie Jane Bryant's story of service began early: at just 14 years old, she was entrusted with a responsibility far beyond her years when her dance teacher, preparing to retire, asked her to take over the dance studio. Bettie Jane rose to the challenge, beginning what would become a 63-year career as a dance instructor, mentor, and community leader. Since 1960, Bettie Jane's Center of Dance Art has welcomed generations of dancers into a true home away from home—where family and service are core values, and where talent is nurtured but character matters most.

For more than six decades, Bettie Jane directed annual benefit dance recitals that celebrated her students' hard work while supporting causes in need across the community. Collectively, those performances generated more than \$200,000 for organizations including Frederick Health, the Frederick County Y.M.C.A., the Maryland School for the Deaf, the Frederick County chapter of the American Cancer Society, and Thomas Johnson High School's stage floor. The studio also raised more than \$175,000 for the Maryland Cystic Fibrosis Foundation in memory of two students lost to the disease.

In 2008, Bettie Jane was diagnosed with breast cancer. Following surgery, radiation, and chemotherapy, she developed a new understanding of the burdens cancer patients and families carry—not only emotionally, but financially and logistically. Out of her own experience came a commitment to help others facing cancer.



In 2009, Bettie Jane, along with her students and studio staff, organized a 5K walk to benefit local cancer patients. The first event raised more than \$10,000. In 2011, she established the Bettie Jane Cancer Foundation, a nonprofit devoted to lifting burdens and meeting vital needs of cancer patients of all kinds. The foundation, run entirely by volunteers, has helped cover costs such as co-pays, medications, transportation, utilities, groceries, childcare, wigs, prostheses, and medical equipment. Since its founding, the Bettie Jane Cancer Foundation has supported hundreds of individuals, each with a different story and a different set of needs. Some needed short-term help; others needed support over the course of long treatment journeys. In every case, the impact reached beyond the patient—easing the strain on their spouses, children, and loved ones.

Under Bettie Jane's leadership, the Bettie Jane Cancer Foundation has generously donated more than \$125,000 to Frederick Health since 2014 as a platinum level member of the Corporate Honor Roll. Their generosity helped build and equip the James M Stockman Cancer Institute, including support for two additional chemotherapy treatment pods and the institute's integrative services program. They also funded improvements to the hospital's critical care service areas. Beyond philanthropy, foundation board members have also regularly volunteered at the Annual Corporate Honor Roll Member Appreciation Golf Outing—often alongside Bettie Jane. Bettie Jane's longstanding connection with the hospital began with her Auxiliary service from 1987 to 2003, where she provided more than 2,000 volunteer hours.

Sadly, after 11 years as a cancer survivor, Bettie Jane was again diagnosed with breast cancer in March 2019. She began hormone therapy, continuing treatment until her passing in February 2023 at the age of 77. She is survived by her beloved husband, daughter, son, five grandchildren, and countless students and friends. Recently, the Bettie Jane Cancer Foundation made a special gift in Bettie Jane's memory to honor the heroes who give the gift of life through organ donation. Inspired by the care Bettie Jane received at Frederick Health in her final months, the Organ Donor Tree of Life—unveiled just outside the hospital's ICU in 2025—stands as a lasting reflection of the way she lived: giving of herself so others could be lifted.

Today, Bettie Jane's dance studio—now managed by her daughter—continues to brighten lives through the joy of movement and the warmth of community. And her foundation—led by people who loved her and learned from her—continues to carry forward her mission of providing hope and support to those in need. Long after her final bow, Bettie Jane's legacy lives on in the rhythm of kindness she set in motion.

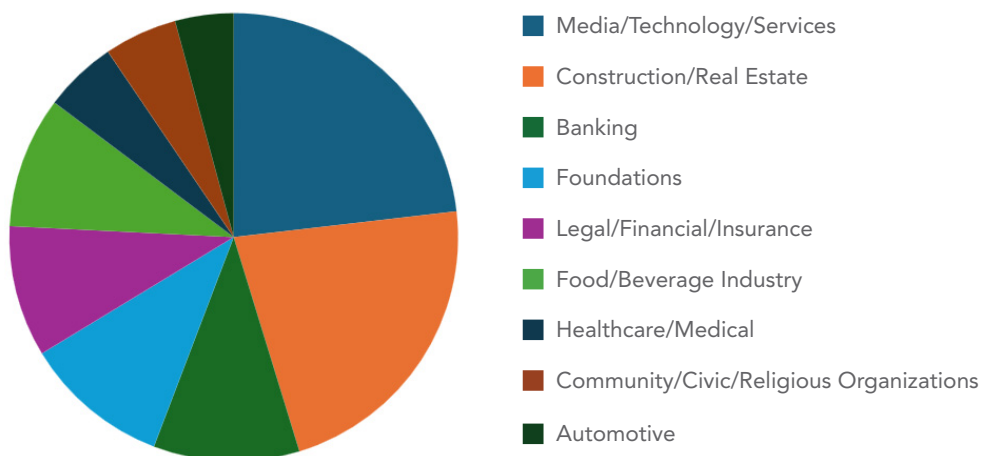

For **Jolena & Patrick Simoneau**, giving back as 1902 Club members is a way to help ensure Frederick Health remains strong for those who depend on it.



Jolena and Patrick Simoneau lead with a shared commitment to showing up for others. Patrick is a leadership coach and consultant with Leading Through, where he helps leaders build stronger, higher-performing teams and advance their careers. Jolena is the owner and creative director of Sun & Moon Balloon Design, a woman-owned balloon décor company specializing in custom designs for corporate events and milestone celebrations. Together, they also lead the Children's Center of Walkersville, their family-owned childcare and preschool that has served the Walkersville community since 1987, where Patrick serves as Operations Administrator and Jolena is the Finance and Operations Manager. Patrick is currently President-Elect of Key City Rotary Club, and he and Jolena both serve on the Club's Board of Directors. Jolena also co-chairs the Women in Business Committee for the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce.

"We believe in being active, present participants in the community around us, whether that looks like bringing a friend a warm meal, writing a neighbor a kind note, or rolling up our sleeves for larger efforts like cleaning up a park or painting a local school," Jolena shares. "We also feel strongly about passing that spirit on to our daughters, and raising them to understand that showing up for others is one of the most important things you can do," adds Patrick.

Jolena and Patrick's two daughters were both born at Frederick Health, but their connection to the hospital deepened when their eldest was hospitalized at age six with Staph Scalded Skin Syndrome. The experience left them grateful for the quick response, diagnosis, and treatment she received, while also giving them a new perspective on how much families depend on clear information, communication, and support throughout a hospital stay. It also made them think about those who may face added barriers in these frightening moments, from language differences to not knowing what questions to ask. "Every family that walks through those doors deserves the same quality, transparent, and consistent care," Jolena says. "That belief is a big part of why we give."

Jolena and Patrick see Frederick Health not just as a hospital, but as an essential part of the community's safety net. "Frederick Health is the hospital for our community," says Patrick. "Not everyone can drive to Johns Hopkins or the University of Maryland when something goes wrong. For most Frederick County families, this is it, and that means it has to be excellent." Philanthropy, Patrick adds, is what helps make this possible. "Charitable giving helps bridge the gap between where the hospital is and where it needs to be," he says.

Through their support, Patrick hopes to help strengthen the systems that make excellent care possible. "Great patient experiences do not happen by accident," he says. "They are the result of strong leadership, aligned teams, and systems that work." For Jolena, the impact is measured in whether families feel informed, supported, and cared for in frightening moments. "I hope our giving helps create experiences where no family is left confused, scared, or feeling like they had to fight for answers," she shares. "That is what I want for every patient and every family in this community."

Why I Volunteer

For more than 30 years, **Brenda Main** has given her time, leadership, and heart to help Frederick Health grow alongside the community she loves.



Born, raised, and educated in Frederick County, Brenda Main is part of a family legacy that spans generations. Her family's agricultural roots shaped her understanding of hard work, connection, and community responsibility. After graduating from Walkersville High School, she earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Hood College and later completed her MBA through Frostburg State University's Frederick satellite campus while working at FCNB Bank. She began as a teller, building relationships with customers before discovering a passion for marketing, advertising, and community engagement—eventually rising to Senior Vice President – Director of Marketing during her 20 years with the bank. “Any time an opportunity presents itself, give it a try,” Brenda said—a mantra that has served her well professionally and as a volunteer. She joined the Annual Support Committee of the Frederick Health Development Council in 1994. At FCNB Bank, Brenda had seen the importance of investing in the community—and supporting the local hospital was a meaningful way to put that belief into action.

More than 30 years later, Brenda remains one of the Development Council's longest-tenured fundraising volunteers. Having previously served as Vice Chair and later Chair of the Annual Support Committee, today she continues to bring her expertise and insight to the Committee. Her reason for staying involved has always been simple: having a strong hospital close to home matters. Through the years, she has seen philanthropy's impact across Frederick Health, but the expansion of interventional cardiology services was especially personal for her. After watching her father face heart issues and travel outside the county for care before certain services were available locally, Brenda knows what it means for families to have advanced care close by.

Brenda joined the Order of the Good Samaritan in 1999 at the encouragement of Pat Linton, then president of FCNB Bank, and she has consistently supported the hospital ever since—reflecting her belief that giving back means showing up however you can and trusting that it makes a difference. To her, Frederick Health is proof of the power of collective support and what it can make possible. “That power has built the hospital,” Brenda said. “There's no other way to say that.” Her advice to anyone considering getting involved is simple: “Take that first step, and you won't regret it.” And for those wondering whether their support matters, Brenda says to look no further than the hospital itself—where babies are born, emergencies are treated, families are supported, and lives are changed every day. “It matters if you get involved. It matters if you donate. It helps everyone,” Brenda says. “The hospital is one of the jewels in our community. We need to support it in any way that we can.”

Why I Give

For **Beth Cucchi**, supporting Frederick Health as an employee donor is a meaningful expression of gratitude, service, and belief in the mission she helps carry forward.



"My love for Frederick Health began long before I became an employee," says Beth Cucchi. Born at Frederick Health Hospital (then known as Frederick Memorial Hospital), Beth's connection to the healthcare system began at birth and has continued through nearly every chapter of her life. 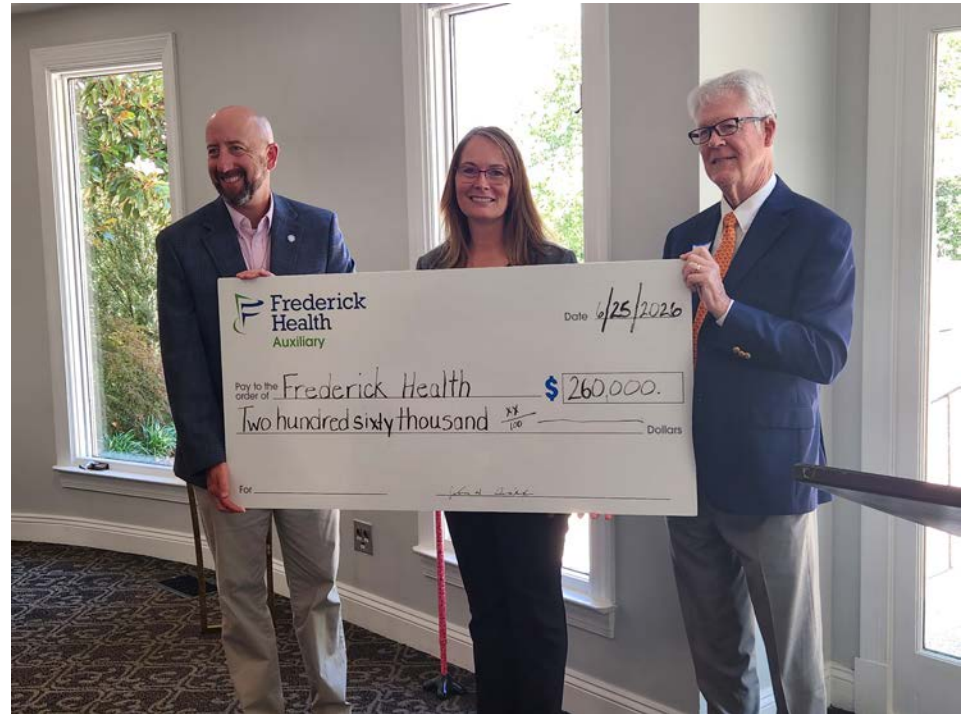

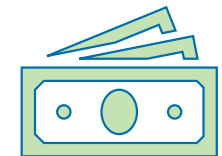

A New Beginning for our Birth Place

Our Birth Place—encompassing Triage, Labor & Delivery, the Newborn Nursery, and the Family Center—is where families are welcomed, guided, and supported from the earliest stages of pregnancy through delivery and postpartum recovery, creating the foundation for safe, healthy beginnings. In December 2025, we marked a major milestone in its renovation and expansion with an updated Labor & Delivery Triage—now serving six expectant moms instead of four—and five new Labor & Delivery rooms, featuring the latest technology and thoughtful improvements designed to enhance comfort, safety, and care for growing families.

Building on this progress, our 2025 Annual Appeal was focused on completing the Birth Place renovation—a key funding priority of our Care for a Lifetime Campaign. Our goal is to complete the renovation of the remaining nine Labor & Delivery rooms and 27 Family Center rooms, with planned updates that include fully modernized bathrooms, new HVAC systems, upgraded medical headwalls, improved lighting, and streamlined furniture. The 2025 Annual Appeal was one of our most successful year-end appeals to date, resulting in more than \$220,000 in cash and pledges received!
